Source 1: Personal Motivation

Strategies

Help Them Love What They Hate

- Link to Mission and Values by having participants create their WHY, HOW and WHAT statements for blended learning.
- Discuss and explain a growth mindset and how that will benefit them as lifelong learners in a blended learning environment.
- Have participants create a collaborative poster with Benefits of Blended Learning at first team meeting.

Source 2: Personal Ability

Strategies

Help Them Do What They Can't

- Provide Training for participants on building content, professional development must begin on how to design content.
- Hold one to one meetings for personal support and encouragement.
- Teachers set up physical classroom to accommodate blended learning promising practices.

Source 3: Social Motivation

Strategies

Provide Encouragement

- Hold monthly meetings with involved administration, leaders and teachers to discuss progress towards goals and hold each other accountable.
- Mentor those who are willing to jump on board first.
- Provide encouragement at monthly meetings for all involved.
- Have opinion leaders and master teachers encourage and support blended learning.

Source 4: Social Ability

Strategies

Provide Assistance

- Share Best Practices in social media groups or collaboration teams with other experts.
- Model and provide support for participants when requested.
- Offer optional meetings for questions or additional support.

Source 5: Structural Motivation

Strategies

Change Their Economy

- Provide incentives for reaching goals such as digital badges, jeans passes or other rewards.
- Provide social recognition for teachers who excel in the implementation of blended learning environment in the District Newsletter and social media channels.
- Teachers earn a pass to Service Center PD on Blended Learning.

Source 6: Structural Ability

Strategies

Change Their Environment

- Ensure that proper wifi is available for teachers and students.
- Ensure that teachers and students have devices appropriate for blended learning.
- Ensure that teachers and students have access to LMS.
